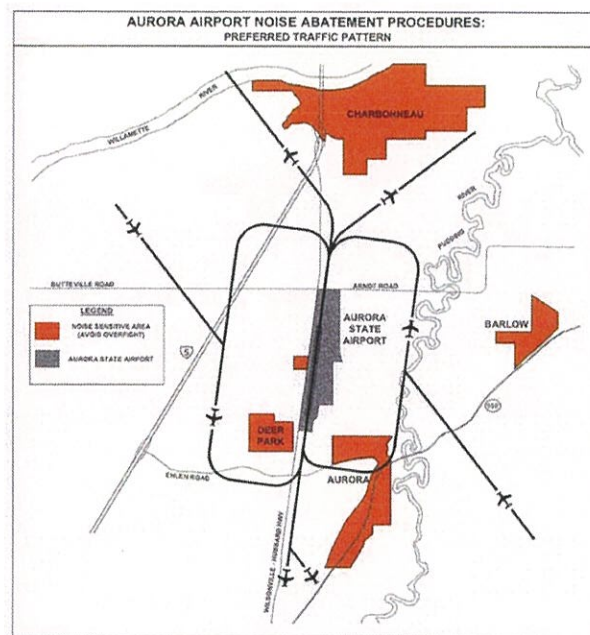

Statement in Opposition to the Aurora Airport Expansion Proposal

November 27, 2018

I am providing my statement to voice my opposition to the proposed expansion of the Aurora Airport. I currently reside at 24850 Prairie View Drive. I have lived there since 2000 and have noticed a steady increase in the number of small planes and jets that violate the FAA flight path rules.

An FAA control tower was installed in 2015 and was supposed to eliminate the violations however they persist. Based on the diagrams provided by the FAA aircraft are to avoid overflight of my property located in the southern area of the Charbonneau labelled orange box:



Airplanes consistently cross the boundary travelling from east to west and pass directly over my home. One jet consistently violates the space early in mornings at 6 and 7 am passing directly over my home travelling from west to east. I don't need an alarm. As I write this letter a plane is passing over my home in clear violation of the noise abatement procedure flight path.

My concern is that a larger runway with larger jets and increased air traffic will make the problem worse continuing to reduce my property value and quality of life in what I believed to be a semi-rural area. I also question the need for the expansion other than to enrich those that stand to benefit from the property purchases and development in the area.
