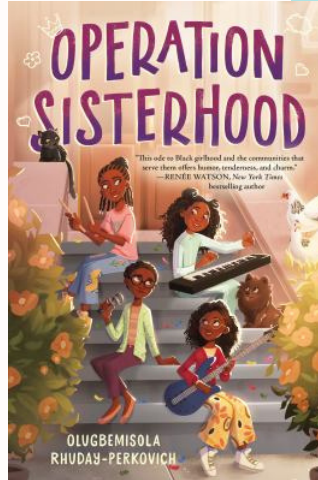

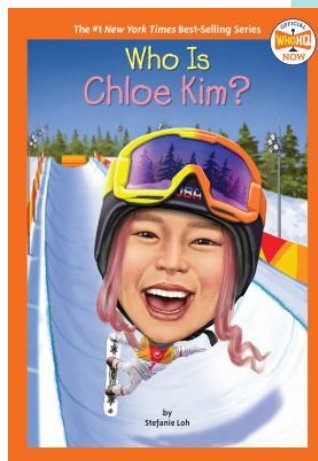

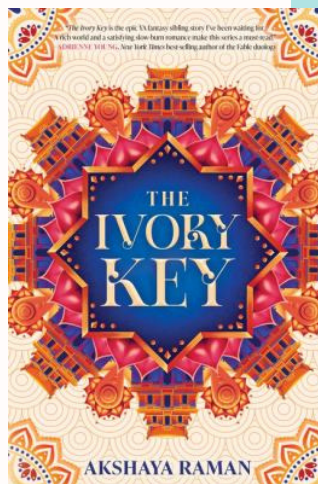
# New Books!

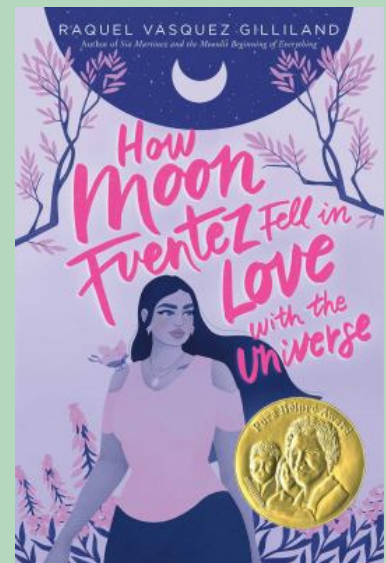
