**LEGO Night** (grades K-5) on Wednesday, February 27th from 6:30 – 7:30pm.

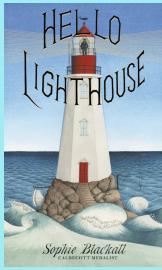

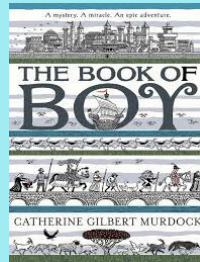

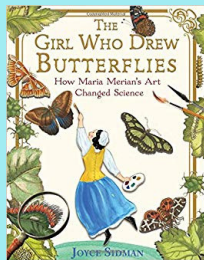

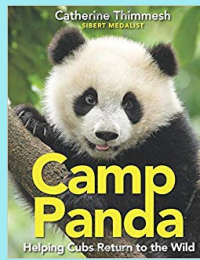

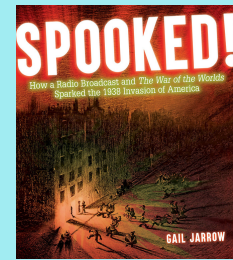

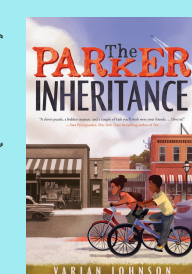
