The renovation is more than half-way done and the end is finally in sight.

The Non-Fiction area has new paint, carpet, and renovated restrooms. The

restrooms are now ADA-compliant and have new paint, tile, and fixtures. Public access to the Non-Fiction area should be available starting in early May.

The magazine reading area has new paint, and will get new carpet and lighting. The reference desk has been removed, and a new desk will be installed in a different location.

The circulation area will receive new paint, carpet, and lighting. The library may have to open later during this period. We will announce the details once we know them.

Library Director Pat Duke is the Oregon Library Association's 2018 Librarian of the Year.

OLA presents the award annually to an Oregon librarian for exceptional service.

The Association cited Pat's contributions to libraries and readers, including outstanding work supporting the formation of the Clackamas County Library District.



Also noted was Pat's passionate advocacy for Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, which provides children up to five years old a free book each month in the mail for them to keep forever.

His work has helped small, rural libraries throughout Oregon provide books to preschoolers, which builds their interest in reading and improves their school readiness.

"This is a wonderful surprise, and I am deeply honored by the recognition by OLA," Pat said.
