

ORDINANCE NO. 129

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING WITHIN SPECIFIED AREA OF PARKWAY AVENUE; PRESCRIBING PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there is an increasing traffic and safety problem on Parkway Avenue which is also State Highway I-5 east frontage road in the City of Wilsonville, and prohibition of parking in certain areas will tend to alleviate some of the problems and provide for better safety of both pedestrians and vehicular traffic; now therefore,

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: No vehicle shall be parked or left standing on the right-of-way of Parkway Avenue, which is also State Highway I-5 east frontage road, from Wilsonville Road South to the intersection of Trask Street and Parkway Avenue.


Section 2: The Oregon State Highway Division shall be notified of this action by the City Administrator who shall file any necessary request on behalf of the council for approval of that agency and the erection of "No Parking" signs.

Section 3: After the "No Parking" signs are erected they shall be official traffic control devices of the City and failure of anyone to obey such official traffic control device commits a Class B Traffic Infraction as defined in Oregon Revised Statutes and shall be punished accordingly.


Section 4: The City's law enforcement officer shall enforce this ordinance after the "No Parking" signs are erected; and the Municipal Court shall have jurisdiction of infractions.
