

ORDINANCE NO. 381

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WILSONVILLE CODE SECTION 2.003 (24) PROVIDING THE CITY ATTORNEY SHALL BE THE PARLIAMENTARIAN.

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


1. Wilsonville Code 2.003 (24) is hereby amended by adding as follows:

"The City Attorney, or in the absence of the City Attorney, his or her designee, shall serve as the Parliamentarian for City Council meetings and such other City meetings as may be needed."
