RESOLUTION NO. 1503

A RESOLUTION DECLARING MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THEIR RELEASE TO THE CITY OF OKANOGAN, WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has prepared a list of material and equipment, attached hereto as Exhibit A, owned by the City of Wilsonville which has been declared to be surplus to the City's needs; and

WHEREAS, Wilsonville City code, Section 2.310, authorizes any purchase, lease or sale by the City Council of personal property, public improvements, or services other than agreements which are exclusively for personal service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Okanogan, Washington, has interest in adding two or three used Rotating Biological Contractor (RBC) shafts (and related appertances) to their existing RBC wastewater treatment process (Exhibit B).

- 1. The materials and equipment listed on the attached Exhibit A, are no longer needed by the City of Wilsonville and are declared surplus property.
