A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE RENEWAL OF THE CLACKAMAS COUNTY SHERIFF PUBLIC SAFETY LOCAL OPTION LEVY ON THE NOVEMBER 8, 2011 ELECTION AS BALLOT MEASURE 3-378.
