

RESOLUTION NO. LI

A RESOLUTION FIXING A TIME FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PETITION OF OREGON ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY FOR AN ORDER DECLARING AND AUTHORIZING THE VACATION OF PORTIONS OF STREETS AND ALLEYS IN WILSONVILLE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, a Petition and Supplemental Petition by Oregon Electric Railway Company have been presented to the City Recorder for the vacation of portions of certain streets and alleys situated in Wilsonville, Clackamas County, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the said Petition has been examined by the City Recorder and found by her to be sufficient and was therefore filed in the City Recorder's office and notice thereof was given to the said petitioner; and

WHEREAS, the said Petition came before the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof on Monday, November 12, 1973, and after consideration of the matter, there appears to be no reason why the Petition should not be allowed in whole, and a time for a formal hearing thereon is required to be fixed and notice thereof given as required by law.

Therefore, it is hereby RESOLVED by the Wilsonville City Council that Monday, January 14, 1974, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m. at the Wilsonville City Hall in Wilsonville, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, is hereby fixed and set as the time and place for a formal hearing on the Petition and Supplemental Petition of Oregon Electric Railway Company for an order of the Wilsonville City Council declaring and authorizing the vacation of portions of streets and alleys situated in Wilsonville, Clackamas County, Oregon, and which areas are particularly described in said Petition and Supplemental Petition.
