

RESOLUTION NO. LXXIX (79)

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING COUNCIL ACTION TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS FOR WATER UTILITY SERVICES IN CANYON CREEK AND BOECKMAN ROADS LID #1--MUNICIPAL WATER.

WHEREAS, the public hearing before the Council on June 28, 1976, revealed facts and produced evidence that wasn't known to the Council, and it appears from the results of that hearing that a substantial majority of the property owners in the proposed Local Improvement District are opposed to the project; now, therefore it is hereby

RESOLVED by the Wilsonville City Council that the action of the Council in declaring its intentions in Resolution No. LXVII (67) adopted October 20, 1975, to make improvements to its municipal water system to provide water to the residents of Canyon Creek and Boeckman Roads and the actions of the Council in re-affirming that intention by Resolution No. LXXVII (77) adopted June 14, 1976, are HEREBY RESCINDED, and the Canyon Creek and Boeckman Roads LID #1 is dissolved effective immediately.
