

RESOLUTION NO. 228

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING STATE WIDE BALLOT MEASURE NO. 4 ENTITLED "RAISES TAXES ON COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL FOR ROADS".


WHEREAS, the State of Oregon is in need of additional revenues for the Highway Fund for maintenance of streets, roads and highways, and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure No. 4 proposes additional revenues generated from increase gas taxes and weight-mile taxes on commercial vehicles for a period beginning July 1, 1982 and continuing through June 30, 1985, and


WHEREAS, the revenue would be shared with the cities and used only for the purpose of street maintenance and repair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Wilsonville City Council supports Ballot Measure No. 4 to raise taxes for fuel and commercial vehicles for maintenance assistance for roads, streets and highways.

ADOPTED by the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof this 3rd day of May, 1982 and filed with the Wilsonville City Recorder this same day.
