SUBJECT: BIDS FOR MOWING AND REMOVAL OF NOXIOUS VEGETATION

Section 6.202 of the Wilsonville Code requires that all property owners, or agent of owners shall cut, remove and keep cut and removed from their respective properties, all weeds and noxious vegetation and all dead bushes, dead trees, stumps or anything likely to cause fire.

This enforcement of the Code does require the City to employ an independent contractor to cut and remove the above stated debris, thereby, bids were called for and three contractors responded as follows:
