A RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY OF WILSONVILLE'S INTENTION AND DETERMINATION OF NECESSITY TO ENTER UPON AND APPROPRIATE LAND AND PROPERTY IN CONNECTION WITH LID #5 TOWN CENTER LOOP ROAD EAST PROJECT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF RELATED SANITARY SEWER, STORM DRAINAGE, WATER, ELECTRICAL AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon, the City of Wilsonville is duly authorized and empowered to establish, locate, construct, lay out, widen, maintain, and repair roads, streets, and highways and to establish, construct, lay out, extend, replace, operate, maintain and repair sanitary sewer, storm drain sewer, water, and provide for electric and telecommunication utility systems as in the judgment of City Council are necessary and proper for the City, and

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon, the City of Wilsonville is duly authorized and may acquire, purchase, enter upon and appropriate land for and in connection with establishing, locating, constructing, laying out, widening, maintaining, and repairing roads, streets, and highways in the City of Wilsonville and may acquire, purchase, enter upon and appropriate land and property for or in connection with establishing, constructing, laying out, extending, replacing, operating, maintaining and repairing

sanitary sewer, storm drain sewer, water, electric and telecommunication utility systems as in the judgment of City Council are necessary and proper to exercise its powers; and

WHEREAS, for the health, safety, benefit and general welfare of the public, the City of Wilsonville has established Local Improvement District No. 5 to plan, locate, lay out, construct, operate, maintain and repair a portion of Town Center Loop Road East, and in conjunction with that public improvement, the City plans to locate, lay out, construct, extend, operate, maintain and repair various sanitary and storm drainage sewers and water systems, and provide for electric and telecommunication utility systems; and

WHEREAS, the Council has previously directed the staff to seek right-of-way acquisition on properties adjacent to the area encompassing LID #5 for the purpose of constructing utility installations abutting Wilsonville Road and Town Center Loop East need for the LID, and the staff and City Attorney have reviewed proposals from the affected property owners which requested the construction of streets in the affected areas without cost to the landowners; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the construction of these improvements in return for the dedication of the land were not in fact in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Public Works

Director and City Attorney that further negotiation for the

acquisition of the properties described in Exhibits "A"

through "D" attached would best be addressed following a

declaration of public necessity for the acquisition of said

property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City of Wilsonville does hereby find and declare that it is needed and required for the location, construction, operation, maintenance, repair and improvement of Town Center Loop East as provided for in Local Improvement District No. 5 that the City acquire, locate, construct, operate, maintain, repair and improve utility systems, including sanitary and storm drainage sewers, water lines, and provide for electric and telecommunication systems on properties located adjacent thereto, more particularly set forth and described in Exhibits "A" through "D" attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein.
- 2. The location, construction, laying out, extension, replacement, operation and repair of the sanitary sewer, storm drainage sewer, water, electric and telecommunication systems for which the land, property and interests therein described in Exhibits "A" through "p" attached hereto and by reference

incorporated herein, is required and is being taken, if necessary, in the public interest, to-wit: To facilitate the location, laying out, widening, construction, maintaining and repairing of Town Center Loop Road East by permitting the construction of related utility systems under the auspices of Local Improvement District No. 5, a project necessary to permit the public's full use and enjoyment of the City's streets and utility systems in a manner that will be most compatible with the greatest public benefit and the least private injury or damage.

- they are hereby authorized, to attempt to agree with the owners and other persons with interests in the land or the property interests herein described in Exhibits "A" through "D", attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein as to the compensation to be paid for the appropriation of the property and, in the event that no satisfactory agreement can be reached, then the attorneys for the City of Wilsonville be, and the same are hereby, directed and authorized to commence and prosecute to a final determination of such proceedings as may be necessary to acquire the land or property interests therein and that, upon the filing of such proceeding, possession of the land and property interests therein may be taken immediately.
 - 4. Upon the trial of any suit or action instituted to

of the public, an emergency exists, and it is necessary that no undue delay be encountered in obtaining access to and possession of the land and/or property interests therein described in Exhibits "A" through "D", in order to establish and construct the aforesaid sewer and utility improvements related to the Construction of Town Center Loop East under the auspices of Local Improvement District No. 5, this resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council.






