RESOLUTION NO. 783

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE EXPRESSING ITS FORMAL SUPPORT OF MAYOR JOHN LUDLOW AND URGING WILSONVILLE CITIZENS TO REFUSE TO SIGN RECALL PETITIONS WHICH MAY BE CIRCULATED.

WHEREAS, a recall effort against Mayor John Ludlow has been announced; and WHEREAS, Mayor Ludlow was elected to office by 1,954 Wilsonville voters; and WHEREAS, Mayor Ludlow has a long and outstanding record of service to the City of Wilsonville; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Ludlow has been honored as Wilsonville's First Citizen by the Wilsonville Rotary Club; and

WHEREAS, the ability to recall elected officials is a precious right granted to citizens under the Oregon Constitution; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Wilsonville City Council recall should be used only in cases of a breach of public trust or malfeasance in office; and

WHEREAS, Mayor John Ludlow has served as Mayor with dedication and integrity.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES as follows:

The Wilsonville City Council expresses its formal support of Mayor
John Ludlow and urges Wilsonville citizens to refuse to sign recall petitions which may be circulated.
