AND DEVELOPMENT

The design development for Phase I construction in Wilsonville Memorial Park is attached. This document was reviewed during the April 29, 1991 City Council/Parks and Recreation Advisory Board workshop. Mike Zilis, Consultant, has also prepared an itemized unit cost fact sheet which lists each portion of the proposed construction project. This information is very valuable for understanding what each project will include as far as specific equipment.

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and staff will be holding a meeting on Friday, May 3, 1991, in order to prioritize the construction projects listed within Phase I. This recommended priority list will be distributed at the pre-Council dinner meeting on May 6.

The Advisory Board and staff understood from Council during the April 29 workshop that they would be in favor of approving an expenditure for Phase I not to exceed \$350,000. This funding would be encumbered from the Park Reserve Fund.

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board requests approval from City Council for expending a maximum of \$150,000 from the Park Reserve Fund to correct the storm drain system in Wilsonville Memorial Park. The Advisory Board feels strongly that the Park Reserve Fund should not be responsible for incurring this expense. The Advisory Board and staff requests that an Agreement be drafted by the City Attorney, Michael E. Kohlhoff, stating that the \$150,000 be replaced to the Parks Reserve Fund from Systems Development Fees by a specific date and year. Mike Zilis, Consultant, and the Advisory Board are still in the process of evaluating the most suitable alternative to correct the storm drain issue. We are requesting that City Council authorize the \$150,000 for the storm drain, yet give the Advisory Board and staff the authority and responsibility to decide and

select the best method and system. If the storm drain project is completed for less than \$150,000 we are requesting that the remaining funds may be transferred to the Phase I construction projects.

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and staff would like to extend a sincere thank you to our Mayor and City Councilors for participating in the Parks workshops. Your input and comments are vital and very helpful as we move forward to park construction in July of 1991.


