A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE'S APPLICATION FOR A CLACKAMAS COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR COMMUNITY CENTER SIGN.

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville Community Center houses a variety of programs that benefit low and moderate income senior citizens, including a hot lunch program, legal and health clinics, classes and other activities; and

WHEREAS, the absence of identifying signage on Wilsonville Road in front of the Community Center is a matter of grave concern to the senior citizens who use the center; and

WHEREAS, the existing configuration of the entry driveway, berm and parking lot can make the Community Center difficult to find, particularly for first-time visitors; and

WHEREAS, a signage project undertaken by the city several years ago neglected to include the Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes this project meets the requirements for a Clackamas County Community Development Block Grant; and

WHEREAS, city staff has completed and submitted an application for a block grant for this project.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES that the City Council of the City of Wilsonville endorses the staff's application for a Clackamas County Community Development Block Grant for a sign on Wilsonville Road at the entry driveway to the Wilsonville Community Center and directs the City Manager to make the required 20% local matching funds available from the city's general fund contingency.
