

RESOLUTION NO. 1372

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CANVASS OF VOTES OF THE MARCH 11, 1997
SPECIAL ELECTION.**

WHEREAS, at a special election held March 11, 1997, the electorate of the City of Wilsonville cast ballots for Measure 3-90 Road Utility Fee; and




2. Based upon the adopted canvass of votes the City Council affirms that Measure 3-90 Road Utility Fee has been defeated by a majority of the votes cast.

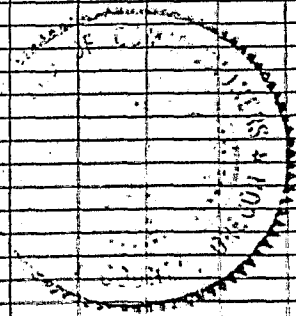
